

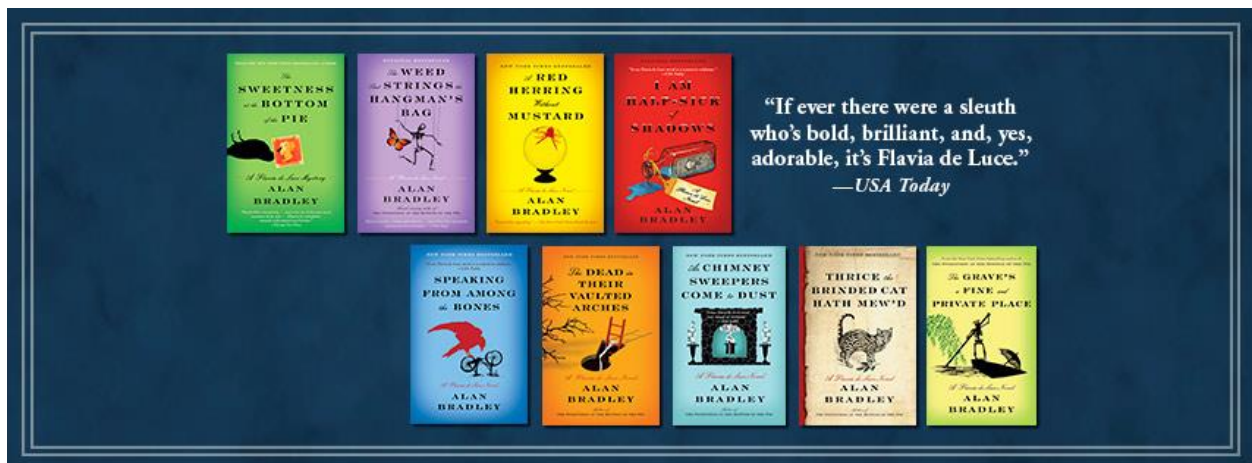

Three major TV projects have come together simultaneously for Bukowski Agency clients via Hotchkiss and Associates in New York.



Alan Bradley's *New York Times* bestselling series of mysteries starring adolescent British sleuth Flavia de Luce have been picked up for series development by producer Robert Mickelson for Canada's CBC in Toronto, with Susan Coyne writing three scripts. Mickelson and Coyne recently collaborated on last year's cinema blockbuster 'The Man Who Invented Christmas.' The ten-volume book series, beginning with *THE SWEETNESS AT THE BOTTOM OF THE PIE*, is published by Delacorte in the USA, Orion in the UK, and Doubleday in Canada, as well as 35 other countries.
